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1. Introduction

1.1. About: STEM World Competition

STEM World Competition is a platform that hosts both national and global robotics and coding challenges. We have hosted competitions with international partners including *Microsoft Minecraft, Matatalab, Sphero, Boson* and many other industrial partners since 2014.

1.2. ABOUT: MINECRAFT EDUCATION EDITION

Minecraft - the bestselling video game of all time – capitalizes on the potential of gamified learning with the release of *Minecraft: Education* Edition. *STEM Academy* recognizes the benefits of a gamified learning, especially for young students, and fully integrates it into our regular educational curriculum to impart coding and programming fundamentals in an engaging manner.

1.3. THEME: BUILD CHALLENGE, CLIMATE CHANGE AND SUSTAINABILITY LIVING

With challenges like climate change which bring about more extreme weather patterns and increasing urbanisation, we need to build a city where residents will be able to enjoy a liveable, sustainable and climate resilient city.

Teams are to build a Minecraft Escape Room where players will be educated and perform tasks to escape a polluted city.

The escape room must have the component:

- 1. NPC asking questions.
- 2. Command blocks.
- 3. Redstone circuits.

As a guiding point, you can use the 5 pillars of the Singapore Green Plan 2030.

- 1. City in Nature
- 2. Energy Reset
- 3. Sustainable Living
- 4. Green Economy
- 5. Resilient Future

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2. CATEGORIES

There are three main categories for Minecraft Education: Challenge 2023:

Main Category	Level of Education
Category A	Primary
Category B	Secondary

Each team should comprise of TWO (2) to Three (3) members.



3. GENERAL RULES

- Registration ends on <u>29th Sept 2023</u>.
- Teams can register online at: https://www.stemacademy.sg/stem-world-competitions
- \$50 registration fee applies for all MOE schools and public teams.
- Each team can purchase Minecraft: Education account from the organiser.
- Participants must be full-time registered students at a school of the correct level for the category they are registering for. They are not allowed to register in categories <u>higher or lower</u> than their educational standard, i.e. Lower Primary school students are not allowed to participate in Category B and Category C. Secondary school students are not allowed to participate in Category A.
- Participants will be notified upon successful registration within one week of registration submission.
- The STEM World Competition organizing committee reserve the right to amend rules and regulation at their own discretion and is responsible for final judgement calls.

- Each team should submit 1 video and 1 Minecraft world
- Video requirements
 - o Include self-introduction of team members (mentors can be excluded)
 - A screen recording of your playthrough should be incorporated into the video. To encourage creative editing, no limits will be imposed on editing styles.
 - Present and explain the logic behind your Minecraft program, ensuring a clear connection to the main theme is established.
- Video submission instructions
 - Step 1: Record video submission
 - o Step 2: Upload the Minecraft world and video to google drive
 - o Step 3: Go to https://www.stemacademy.sg/competition-submission
 - Step 4: Fill up the form and submit Google drive link
